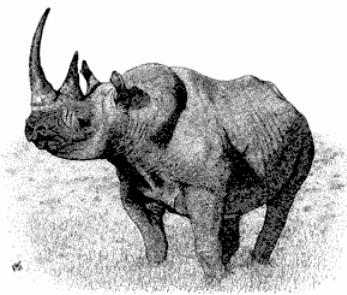


12 – DAY TANZANIA BIODIVERSITY SAFARI

This participation camping safari is designed for students or other groups interested in a lower cost but highly interactive wildlife and cultural safari experience. Participants must bring their own sleeping bags and ground pads, set up and take down their tents and help with the cooking and dish washing. This safari provides opportunities for walking, visiting with local people and game drives



DAY 1 – U.S. / AMSTERDAM

International air from the U. S. is additional to the safari cost.

DAY 2 – AMSTERDAM / KILIMANJARO AIRPORT / ARUSHA

Following your arrival at the Kilimanjaro International Airport you are met and transferred to the **Impala Hotel**.

DAY 3 – ARUSHA / LOSIRWA VILLAGE

Following breakfast you drive to Losirwa Village in the Great Rift Valley. After setting up your tents you visit a local primary school, visit with the teachers and students and gain an appreciation for Tanzania's education system. Your participation in a community service project and traditional African meal prepared and eaten following the local customs further acquaints you with the African way of life. B/PL/D

DAY 4 – LOSIRWA VILLAGE

Following breakfast you walk to a Maasai village. Soon after your arrival the men will join the warriors to herd cattle and the women will go to collect wood and water. While in the village you visit the school and medical clinic, see their homes and try your hand at milking a cow or at some traditional bead work before returning to your camp for dinner. B/L/D

DAY 5 - LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK / KARATU / LOSIRWA VILLAGE

In the morning you depart for Lake Manyara National Park, famous for its tree-climbing Lions and a thriving population of Elephant. In the afternoon you visit the Akwesoo Iraqw Cultural Center for an introduction to the ancient culture of the Cushitic people before returning to your camp for dinner. B/PL/D

DAY 6 – LOSIRWA VILLAGE / OLDUVAI GORGE / SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast you drive around the rim of the Ngorongoro Crater before descending to **Olduvai Gorge**, one of the world's most important prehistoric archaeological sites. In the afternoon you drive across the great Serengeti plains, game viewing along the way. Your dinner and overnight accommodations are at the **Serengeti Adventure Camp**. B/PL/D

DAYS 7 & 8 – SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

Morning and afternoon game drives take you to different location of this vast wildlife area. Our evening discussions provide an opportunity of practicing your Swahili, learning about Maasai culture and the natural history of some of the wildlife you are seeing. Dinner is served under the star-studded African sky and as the evening temperature falls, you appreciate the warmth of the campfire. B/PL/D

DAY 9 – SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK / NGORONGORO CRATER

In the morning you drive back across the vast Serengeti plains to the Ngorongoro Crater, one of the most spectacular and beautiful wildlife areas in the world. Following your arrival at the Ngorongoro Adventure Camp you have lunch before departing for the crater floor. Your accommodations for the next two nights, at the **Ngorongoro Adventure Camp**, on the crater's rim provides a spectacular overview of one of the most beautiful wildlife arenas on earth. B/L/D

DAY 10 – NGORONGORO CRATER

Following breakfast you return to the crater floor for a 2nd game drive in this spectacular wildlife sanctuary. There are usually more than 20,000 animals resident in the crater, including the highest density of lion found in Africa. Your meals and overnight accommodations are at the Ngorongoro Adventure Camp. B/L/D

DAY 11 – NGORONGORO CRATER / ARUSHA / AMSTERDAM

In the morning you drive back to Arusha and check into dayrooms at the Impala Hotel. In the afternoon you have an opportunity to shop or rest in preparation for the return to the U.S. In the evening you gather for a farewell dinner before departing for the Kilimanjaro Airport. B/L/D

DAY 12 – AMSTERDAM / U.S.

B = Breakfast; L = Lunch; PL = Picnic Lunch; D = Dinner; () = In-flight meal

- Opportunities for walking, visiting with local people and game drives.
- Customized safari vehicles, guaranteed window seat & access to the roof hatch.
- Professional English speaking naturalist driver/guides
- All meals, park entrance fees, transfers and portage
- Membership in the Flying Doctors Program
- Complete pre-departure information including a check list of what to bring, bird & mammal check lists, luggage tags and passport wallets.

Based on 10 full fare participants with one free (land only) trip leader, World Discovery Safaris 2010 costs are \$3525 per person, double occupancy. The single supplement cost is \$300.

COST INCLUDES:

- 1) Meet and greet on arrival and a welcome briefing
- 2) All transfers
- 3) All meals
- 4) All game drives, activities, Maasai village and school visits.
- 5) Olduvai Gorge visit
- 6) All taxes service charges and park fees
- 7) Transportation in 4x4 Toyota Land Cruisers
- 8) Expert Safari Legacy naturalist safari guides
- 9) Bottled water and refreshments while on game drives
- 10) Temporary membership in Flying Doctors Service
- 11) All community service projects and beads for bead work with the Maasai



* In summary these costs include everything except international air, tips to safari guides and camp/lodges staff, passport and visa fees, items of personal nature such as laundry, souvenirs, alcoholic beverages, sodas, and telephone and internet charges.
