

# KENYA

## 12 – Day Rift Valley Classic Camps



*No other location in the world can offer a comparable diversity of habitats and variety of wildlife. During this 12- day safari you should be able to find approximately 45-50 species of mammals, 400 - 450 species of birds and much more. You will experience this in your private, custom built, four wheel drive Land Rover, guided and driven by one of the few guides who have attained the silver level certification of the Kenya Professional Safari Guides Association (there are only 130 in the whole of East Africa).*

### **DAY 1 - NAIROBI**

After clearing immigration and customs in the Nairobi International Airport you are met and transferred to the Fairmont Norfolk Hotel for the remainder of the night.

### **DAYS 2, 3 & 4 – NAIROBI / SAMBURU GAME RESERVE**

Following breakfast you transfer to the Wilson Airport and fly to the Samburu Game Reserve. Your accommodations, for the next three nights are at Samburu Intrepids. Morning and afternoon game drives take you into the semi-desert thorn bush bordering the Uaso Nyiro River. B/L/D

### **DAYS 5 & 6 – SAMBURU GAME RESERVE / OL PEJETA CONSERVANCY**

Following breakfast you drive south to the Ol Pejeta Conservancy and your accommodations at the Ol Pejeta Ranch House. This conservancy is one of eight heavily protected sanctuaries, which together provide a safe habitat for half of Kenya's black rhino population. In addition the Ol Pejeta Conservancy provides a safe haven for the endangered Grevy's zebra, reticulated giraffe an expanding population of wild dog and a 300-acre sanctuary for orphaned or abandoned chimpanzees. B/L/D

### **DAY 7 – LAIKIPIA / LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK**

Following breakfast you drive to Lake Nakuru National Park, on the floor of the Great Rift Valley, and check into your accommodations at Lion Hill Lodge. In the afternoon you depart on a game drive into this beautiful wildlife sanctuary. B/L/D

### **DAY 8 - LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK**

Over 400 species of birds have been recorded in Lake Nakuru Park and you will most likely find Rothschild's giraffe, Grant's and Thomson's gazelle, impala, common zebra, African buffalo, eland, waterbuck and several other species of plains game. This is a good place to find leopard, and several rhino, of both African species, have been relocated into the park. B/L/D

### **DAYS 9, 10 & 11 – LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK / MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE**

In the morning you drive to the world famous Masai Mara Game Reserve. Your meals and accommodations for the next three nights are at Mara Intrepids Camp. Located in the center of the Maasai Mara National Reserve, above a sweeping bend in the Talek River and near one of the major wildlife migration crossings, this camp offers 10 luxurious, well-spaced tents, each with its own private deck overlooking the river.

A day of fishing for Nile perch in Lake Victoria, a hot air balloon ride over the savanna and a visit to a Maasai village are optional (at additional cost) activities that can be worked into the schedule. B/L/D

### **DAY 12 –MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE / NAIROBI**

In the morning you fly back to Nairobi and check into dayrooms at the Panari Hotel. In the afternoon you may swim, shop or relax in one of the hotel lounges. In the evening you transfer to the Nairobi Airport and check in for your flight to the U.S. (cost not included). B/L
