

“OUT OF AFRICA”

13-Day Hemingway Style Kenya Safari



DAY 1 – NAIROBI (KAREN BLIXEN COTTAGES)

Following your arrival at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi, you clear customs and are met by your Kenyan safari guides and transfer to the Karen Blixen Cottages (5 star) for the remainder of the night.

DAY 2 – NAIROBI

You have the entire day to enjoy the pleasant surroundings of the Karen Blixen Cottages and the many nearby attractions. The Blixen Museum, the Daphni Sheldrick Animal Orphanage, Kazuri Beads, Utamaduni Crafts, Giraffe Manor and the Bomas of Kenya are just minutes away. B/L/D

DAY 3 – SATURDAY – MARCH 7 - NAIROBI / TSAVO WEST NATIONAL PARK (FINCH HATTON’S)

In the morning you fly to Tsavo West National Park and your accommodations for the next three nights at Finch Hatton’s Safari Camp (5 star). Located in the heart of Kenya’s largest game reserve, this luxurious camp has been carefully designed around a natural freshwater spring which flows through three crystal clear pools. The camp is unfenced and wild. Named for the aristocratic bush pilot of “Out Of Africa” fame, Finch Hatton’s is considered one of the most elegant tented camps in Africa. B/L/D

DAYS 4 & 5 - TSAVO NATIONAL PARK (FINCH HATTON’S)

Morning and afternoon game drives and nature walks provide you with numerous opportunities to watch and photograph the abundant wildlife found here. On one of the mornings here your breakfast will be served, "Hemmingway style", in the bush, with snow-capped Mt. Kilimanjaro in the background. In the evening you return to the private comfort of Finch Hatton’s Safari Camp for a sundowner before dinner. B/L/D

DAY 6 – TSAVO NATIONAL PARK / SAMBURU GAME RESERVE (LARSEN’S CAMP)

In the morning you fly north to the Samburu Game Reserve and your accommodations for the next three nights at **Larsen’s**, a luxurious tented camp in a beautiful setting on the banks of the Uaso Nyiro River. Tranquility and nature embrace you the minute you enter Larsen’s. If one of your lifelong ambitions is to experience the Africa known to the country’s intrepid pioneers, far from the beaten track and in the special solitude that allows a unique kinship with nature, then at Larsen’s your dream will come true. B/L/D

DAYS 7 & 8 - SAMBURU GAME RESERVE (LARSEN’S CAMP)

Morning and afternoon game drives take you into the semi-desert thorn bush bordering the Uaso Nyiro River. One of our reasons for coming to this remote area is to find and photograph wildlife characteristic of the “Horn of Africa” and not found far south of the semi-arid Samburu region. Your meals and overnight accommodations are Larsen’s Camp. B/L/D

DAYS 9, 10 & 11 – SAMBURU GAME RESERVE / MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE

In the morning you fly to the world famous Masai Mara Game Reserve and Cottar’s 1920’s Safari Camp. Recalling an era of romance and luxury, Cottar’s Camp, adjacent to the Maasai Mara Game Reserve, is a step back in time to the golden days of 'the safari'- an era of professional guiding, adventure and elegance, in a timelessly unspoiled setting with panoramic views and boundless game. The camp accommodates up to twelve guests in spacious white canvas tents, luxuriously furnished with original safari antiques from the '20's; private en suite dressing rooms and bathrooms, with old-fashioned styled tubs, showers and flush toilets, a central bedroom and an outdoor veranda. Activities include game drives guided by Calvin Cottar, or guides of an equal professional standard, in either state of the art modern four wheel drive vehicles, in an authentic, old wooden car or in an oxen drawn wagon. Dinner is served under the star-studded African sky and, as the evening temperature falls, we appreciate the warmth of the campfire. Your overnight accommodations are at Cottar’s Safari Camp. B/L/D

DAY 12 – MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE / NAIROBI / U. S.

Your morning game drive provides a final opportunity to spend time with the wild herds of this area. Later in the morning you transfer to the airstrip for the 45-minute flight back to Nairobi. Following your arrival you are met and transferred to your dayrooms at the Karen Blixen Cottages. In the evening you join your safari guides, depart for the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport and check in for your flights to the U.S. B/L/D

DAY 13 – U.S.

You return to your homes with a collection of wonderful feelings and memories of Kenya that words and photos cannot completely describe.
