12 – DAY Rift Valley Luxury Safari

Operated by Origins Safaris

Flights between wildlife parks and ground transportation in 4x4 Land Rovers these safaris are escorted by one or more of Kenya's few KPSGA SILVER CERTIFIED professional naturalist / guides.

DAY 1 - NAIROBI

After clearing immigration and customs in the Nairobi International Airport you are met and transferred to the Palacina Hotel for the remainder of the night.

DAYS 2, 3 & 4 – NAIROBI / SAMBURU GAME RESERVE

Following breakfast you transfer to the Wilson Airport and fly to the Samburu Game Reserve. Your luxurious accommodations, for the next three nights are at Larsen's Camp. Morning and afternoon game drives take you into the semi-desert thorn bush bordering the Uaso Nyiro River and you visit a Samburu village for an introduction to the daily life of these pastoral people. B/L/D

DAYS 5 & 6 – SAMBURU GAME RESERVE / MERU NATIONAL PARK

Following breakfast you drive to Meru National Park where your accommodations for the next two nights are at Elsa Kopje. Meru National Park, in the old Northern Frontier District, is wild Africa at its best. Its varied habitats contain a wide diversity of wildlife including elephant, lion, cheetah, leopard, both common and Grey's zebra, some of Kenya's largest herds of buffalo and several species of antelope including common waterbuck, beisa oryx, lesser kudu, bush duiker and Kirk' dik-dik. B/L/D

DAYS 7 & 8 – MERU NATIONAL PARK / LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK

In the morning you transfer to the nearby airstrip and board your charter flight to Lake Nakuru National Park, famous for its thousands of pink flamingos. This is a good place to find Leopard and small populations of rhino, of both African species, have recently been moved into the park where they receive round-the-clock protection. After checking into your accommodations at **Chui Lodge** you depart on a game drive in this beautiful wildlife sanctuary. B/L/D

DAYS 9,10 & 11 - LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK / MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE

In the morning you fly to the world famous Masai Mara Game Reserve. Your meals and accommodations for the next three nights are at Mara Explorer Camp. Located in the center of the Maasai Mara National Reserve, above a sweeping bend in the Talek River and near one of the major wildlife migration crossings, this exclusive five-star camp offers 10 luxurious, well-spaced tents, each with its own private deck overlooking the river. For an extra fee a day of fishing for the giant Nile perch in Lake Victoria (\$475), a hot air balloon ride over the savanna (\$450) and a visit to a Maasai village (\$20) are optional activities that can be worked into the schedule. B/L/D

DAY 12 –MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE / NAIROBI

In the morning you fly back to Nairobi and check into dayrooms at the Panari Hotel. In the afternoon you may swim, shop or relax in one of the hotel lounges. In the evening you transfer to the Nairobi Airport and check in for your flight to the U.S. (cost not included). B/L

B = Breakfast; L = Lunch; D = Dinner

***Note:** During this safari you should be able to find approximately 45-50 species of mammals, 400 - 450 species of birds and much more.*
