DAY 1 – SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 30 - DEPART U.S.

DAY 2 – MONDAY, OCTOBER 1 - ARRIVE KILIMANJARO / ARUSHA, TANZANIA

In the evening we arrive at the Kilimanjaro International Airport and transfer to the **Arusha Serena Lodge**.

DAY 3 – TUESDAY, OCTOBER 2 - ARUSHA / TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

In the morning we depart for **Tarangire National Park**. Our meals and accommodations, for two nights are at the **Lake Burunge Tented Lodge**. B/L/D

DAY 4 – WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 3 - TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

We spend the day exploring the 2600 sq km's of **Tarangire National Park** – famous for its numerous baobab trees and large elephant population. B/L/D

DAY 5 – THURSDAY, OCTOBER 4 - TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK / LOSIRWA VILLAGE/ LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK / KARATU

In the morning we depart with a picnic lunch, drive out of Tarangire National Park, descend to the floor of the Great Rift Valley and arrival at Losirwa Village. Tree planting projects, such as the one we will be involved with here, are designed to provide us with the opportunity to interact with rural Tanzanians on a one to one basis, establish a genuine cross cultural interaction with these people and help us understand their way of life. In the afternoon we drive to Lake Manyara National Park, a beautiful wildlife sanctuary famous for its tree-climbing Lions, herds of African Buffalo, and a thriving population of Elephant. In the afternoon we drive to our accommodations at the **Lake Manyara Wildlife Safari Camp**. B/PL/D

DAY 6 – FRIDAY, OCTOBER 5 – MTO-WA-MBU VILLAGE & AKWESO IRAQW CULTURAL CENTER

In the morning we visit the village of Mto-wa-Mbu which is located on the floor of the Great Rift Valley. Here we join a local guide who introduces us to the medical, agricultural and cultural practices of this diverse community. After a traditional lunch, we drive to the village of Karatu and visit the Akweso Iraqw Cultural Center. We may also have time to visit the Shalom Orphanage before checking into our accommodations at the **Tloma Mountain Lodge**. B/L/D

DAY 7 – SATURDAY, OCTOBER 6 - KARATU / LAKE EYASI AREA

Early this morning we depart for the Lake Eyasi area to visit the Hadzapi and Datoga tribal groups. The Hadzapi are one of the few remaining tribes of nomadic hunter, gatherers that do not live in villages. There are fewer than 600 individual members and they speak one of Africa's oldest "click" languages. Later in the day we'll spend some time with the pastoral Datoga. In the afternoon we drive to our accommodation at the **Ngorongoro Farm House**. B/L/D

DAY 8 – SUNDAY, OCTOBER 7 - NGORONGORO CRATER

After an early breakfast we depart with a picnic lunch for a full day's game drive on the crater floor. Ngorongoro is the largest unbroken crater on earth, a veritable Garden of Eden where the year-round grazing and fresh water available provides a permanent home for approximately 23,000 large mammals. In the afternoon we return to the **Ngorongoro Farm House**. B/L/D

DAY 9 – MONDAY, OCTOBER 8 - NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA / OLDUVAI GORGE / SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK (CENTRAL AREA)

After breakfast we visit **Olduvai Gorge**, one of the world's most important prehistoric archaeological sites. In the afternoon we drive across the great Serengeti plains, game viewing along the way, to our accommodations at **Kati Kati Camp**. B/L/D

DAY 10 – TUESDAY, OCTOBER 9 - SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

The Serengeti is the largest and most famous of Tanzania's superb national parks with the greatest and most spectacular concentration of large mammals to be found anywhere on Earth. We explore this vast wildlife area with morning and afternoon game drives and, in the evening return to our tented accommodations at **Kati Kati Camp**. B/L/D

DAYS 11 & 12 – WEDNESDAY & THURSDAY, OCTOBER 10 & 11 - SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK (NORTHERN SERENGETI)

Following breakfast we depart on an extended game drive to the northern segment of the Serengeti. Here the migratory herds of Wildebeest, Zebra and Thompson's Gazelle must cross the Mara River as they travel north from Serengeti's short grass plains into Kenya's Masai Mara Game Reserve. Our accommodations for these two nights are at **Kogatende Camp**. B/L/D

DAY 13 – FRIDAY, OCTOBER 12 - SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK / ARUSHA / DEPART

In the morning we drive to a nearby airstrip and board the scheduled light aircraft flight to Arusha. After lunch and an opportunity to shop at Cultural Heritage (www.culturalheratagetz.com) we transfer to dayrooms at the **Arusha Serena Lodge**. In the evening we join our Tanzanian hosts for a farewell dinner before departing for the Kilimanjaro Airport. B/L/D

DAY 14 – SATURDAY, OCTOBER 13 - ARRIVE U. S.

We arrive back in the U.S. this afternoon with many fond memories of our wildlife safari in Tanzania.

B = Breakfast; L = Lunch; D = Dinner

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WHAT IS INCLUDED: Services of World Discovery Safaris and Maasai Magic, all accommodations and meals as per this itinerary, all land transportation in Tanzania in 4x4 Land Cruisers with top quality, English speaking naturalist/guides and a guaranteed window seat for each passenger, entrance fees at all the parks and sites visited during this safari, bottled water in the safari vehicles, Serengeti / Arusha domestic flight, airport transfers on days 2 & 13 of this safari, hotel taxes as imposed by government agencies and membership in the Flying Doctors program.

NOT INCLUDED: Costs of international air to and from the Kilimanjaro Airport, passports, visas, (a visa for U.S. passport holders to enter Tanzania is currently required), immunizations, excess baggage charges, transfers to and from airports other than on days 2 & 13 of this safari, trip insurance and items of a personal nature, such as travel insurance, bottled drinks other than those listed in the included (above) laundry and telephone and tips for camp staff and driver / guides.

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
